Vision

The Advance exists to share the love of Jesus Christ by offering hope and alleviating human suffering. With integrity, transparency, and a commitment to The United Methodist Church's connectional vision of the world, we will become the leading conduit that enables people to support projects and missionaries throughout the world in order to strengthen and sustain one another.

Mission

The Advance is an accountable, designated giving arm of The United Methodist Church that ensures 100% of each gift is used for its intended mission or ministry. Our work fulfills both physical and spiritual needs through a variety of partnerships worldwide, to reach mutual goals that make a life-changing and long-lasting impact.

Steps Toward a Covenant Relationship:

1. Agree on a group, such as Missions Committee or special task group or the Church Council to study the kit and do some preparation for a recommendation.
2. Prayerfully seek a challenging but realistic annual financial goal for your covenant relationship. Select the annual \$2,500 gift or calculate a gift based on \$5 per member. Some churches put this in the annual budget. Other churches do special fund-raisers, including asking the members to pay the amount per member!
 - a. An individual can establish a Covenant Relationship with a missionary for \$500 or more per year.
 - b. The Advance encourages the development of Covenant Relationships between young adult missionaries (US-2 and Mission Interns) and youth groups or campus ministries for \$5 per group member.
3. Select a missionary by doing research:
 - a. Browse the General Board of Global Ministries web site at <http://new.gbgm-umc.org/work/missionaries/biographies/>. Select by country or other option, or browse alphabetically. Note that some missionaries are apparently not available for our conference. But if you find you are led to such a missionary, consult Laddie Perez-Galang (at d. below) for advice. We may be the first in our Conference to support the missionary you wish!
 - b. Ask other United Methodist churches if they would suggest a missionary.
 - c. Consult retired missionaries. You will find information on retired missionaries at <http://www.cnumc.org/page.asp?PKValue=1229> – CA-NV web page.
 - d. Consult your Conference Secretary of Global Ministries, [Laddie Perez-Galang – 1755 Sunnyvale Avenue, Walnut Creek, CA 94597-1809; \(510\) 396-2347; laddieg@pacbell.net](#) or mz.buzy@gmail.com.
 - e. Consult your District Secretary of Global Ministries, or your District Superintendent, to find out which missionaries are supported by churches in your district.
 - f. Complete the paperwork, select a payment schedule, and follow the directions for copies and mailing. Consult Laddie Perez-Galang (at d above) for any questions on the paperwork!

What to Expect in a Covenant Relationship:

You will enjoy the deep satisfaction of having a personal friend in global ministry! Your church and this global friend will be in mutual prayer support for each other's concerns and ministries. You will enjoy getting in-depth knowledge of a particular place in the world.

You will receive regular communication from the missionary. All missionaries do at least a newsletter, three times a year.

Make regular contact by mail, sending a birthday card, Christmas card, etc. Pictures of your congregation, drawings by children, and other friendly communication, are welcome!

Some missionaries have e-mail and can send and share friendship, news and mutual prayer request this way!

When your missionary is on "itineration," your church will have priority for a visit. The missionary will be able to speak, show slides or other visuals of their work and people, and answer questions. Sometimes the missionary can be the Sunday preacher for your worship service. Sometimes you will be able to have a special evening or Saturday fellowship and educational event with your guest. Neighboring churches and/or the public can be invited.

Your Conference Secretary of Global Ministries and/or the missionary will notify you when they are due for a visit. It is about every three years.

And Furthermore...

As we celebrate covenant relationships between congregations and missionaries, your church will be recognized with a certificate for one of the following reasons:

1. You are a "Covenant Relationship" church recognized by General Board of Global Ministries. You have just started out or have kept renewal paperwork going every year.
2. You may have established such a relationship and have continued to send gifts, but have not done official renewal paperwork. We are calling you a "Covenant Relationship" church anyway!
3. You have sent the appropriate gifts for "Covenant Relationship," but didn't know there was any paperwork involved, so you have not been listed as such!
4. You have sent gifts that fit the description of covenant relationship gifts, but you didn't know that you could be a "Covenant Relationship" church!

I encourage your church now to review its ongoing or new commitment to a missionary in the Covenant Relationship Program. The Covenant Relationship form and instructions are on pages 5 and 6 of this document.
