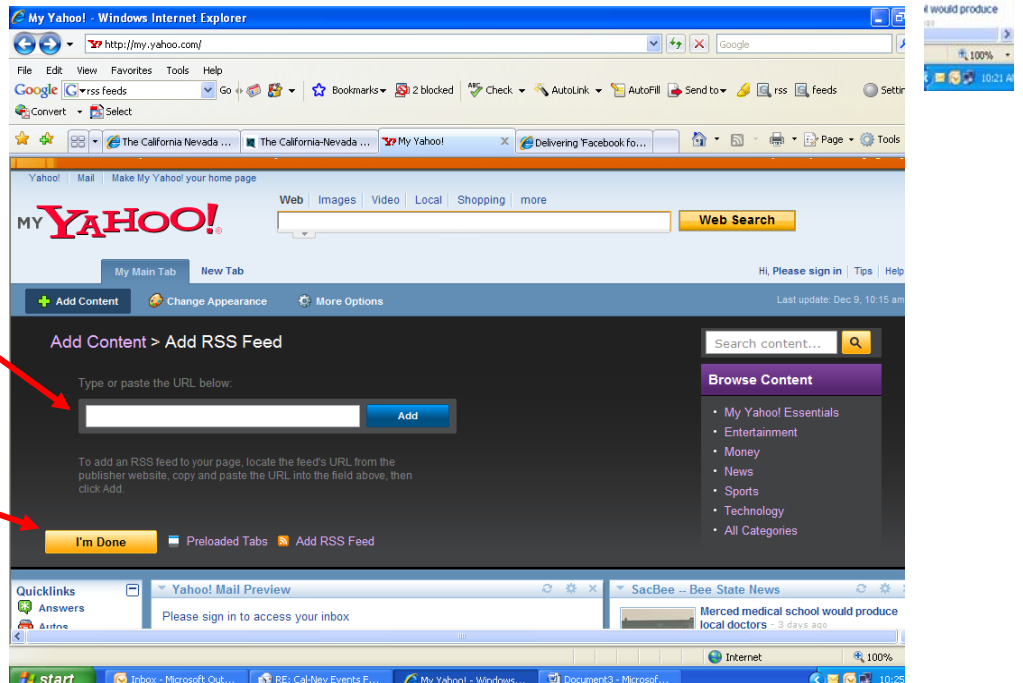
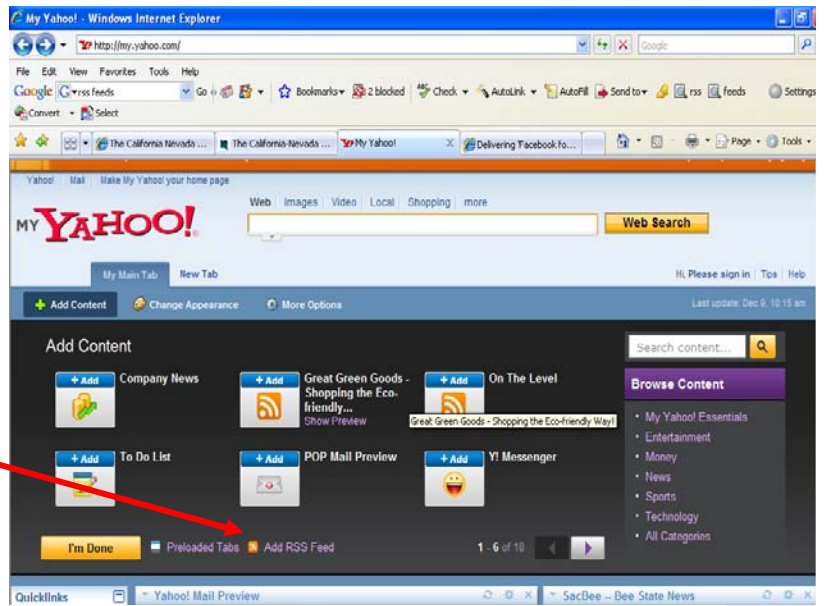
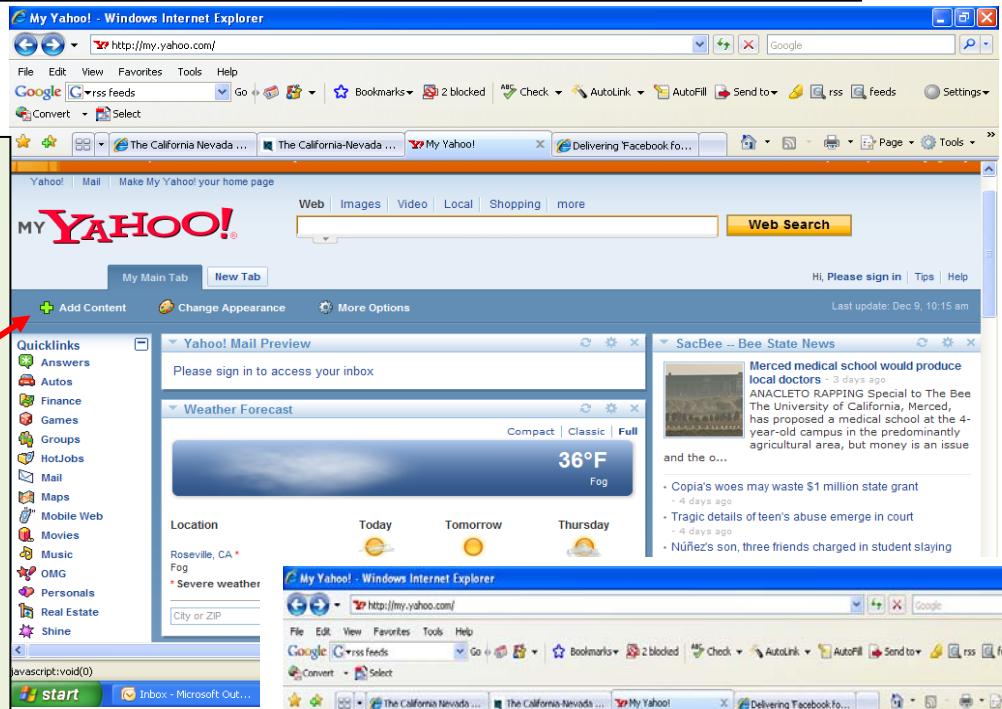

Adding an RSS Feed to a Google Page

Type in: www.google.com/reader into your browser bar.

Click on "Create an Account."

Click on "Add a subscription."

Copy and paste the URL for the RSS Feed into the box:
